This per diem formulary is designed to manage cost across therapy categories.

TherapySelect offers a broad array of formulary inclusions across therapies most commonly utilized to treat the nursing home resident. Formulary inclusions range from long standing commonly prescribed generic medications to innovator brand medications. The exclusion categories are limited and easy to understand.

TherapySelect clients receive easy to understand monthly billing statements, including electronic billing options, online clinical reporting through ViewMasterRx, and professional, solutions-oriented account management.

Your account will be reconciled as frequently as quarterly to assess any opportunities to lower cost and reset the per diem rate.

The following medication list is excluded from the formulary program: New Brand Drug Medications unless added to the formulary, HIV, Infertility & reproductive therapies, sexual dysfunction, cancer treatments, wound care, debridement, blood and blood derivatives, weight loss, cosmetic, herbal and homeopathic, prevention medications for transplants, nutritional and TPN, vaccines, serums, toxoids, specialty drugs, medical supplies, non-standard IV supplies, devices, diagnostic products, compounded medications, medications greater than \$25 per day, Part B covered medications, and OTC's.
